Investigating differences in perception of natural scenes and aesthetics between Autismspectrum disorder and neurotypical individuals

Two sessions : 1 hour session & 2 hour session Simple online iPad based tasks (personal iPad required) Compensation is provided ; love2shop voucher worth £20 or 1 SONA credit per 15 minutes

We are seeking adults aged 18-30 with normal colour vision for our study on natural scene and aesthetic perception. The study involves two sessions; in the first one participants will be asked to complete a series of questionnaires and a colour vision deficiency test and in the second session participants will be shown a series of images and be asked to produce two ratings about them. There will be breaks allowed between tasks and compensation will be provided (love2shop voucher worth £20 or 1 SONA credit per 15 minutes). Please note: in order to complete this study **participants must have their own iPad** (iPad mini's and other tablet computers do not count).
