Visual aesthetic preference in autism-spectrum disorder and neurotypical individuals

Three-part study: 20 min pre-screening stage, 1hr30mins session & 1hr10mins session Simple online iPad based tasks (personal iPad required)

We are seeking adults aged 18-30 with normal colour vision for our study on natural scene and aesthetic perception. There are three parts to the study – the first is a pre-screening stage which will last approximately 20 minutes, then if after this stage participants are eligible to continue there will be two following sessions lasting 1 hour 30 minutes and 1 hour 10 minutes. Concerning the sessions; in the first one participants will be asked to complete a series of questionnaires and in the second session participants will be shown a series of images and be asked to produce two ratings about them. The tasks will be spread out across two days and there will be breaks allowed between tasks. Compensation will be provided (love2shop voucher worth £20).

Please note: in order to complete this study **participants must have their own iPad** (iPad mini's and other tablet computers do not count).
