There is a door entry system. Please press the button marked “Scottish Autism” and someone will ask for your name and who you are here to see over the buzzer system. You will here a buzzing noise, you can then push the door to enter the building. Once inside someone will open the double doors to your right, seen in the photos below, for you to enter our reception area.
