

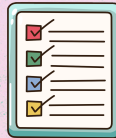


Call for Participants



About the Study

As part of a PhD study, we are exploring the friendship experiences of autistic adolescents in Scottish secondary schools to understand what supports friendship-making and what creates barriers to it.



Who can participate?

Young people who are:

- Aged 11-18
- Autistic or Neurotypical
- Attending a mainstream secondary school in Scotland.

AND

Practitioners who are:

- Current or previous employment in mainstream secondary schools in Scotland
- Direct experience of working with autistic students (not necessarily those taking part in this study).

What does taking part involve?



✓ Online survey (15-20 mins) for autistic and neurotypical students

🎨 Optional zine-making for autistic students (creative, relaxed activity)

💬 Interview/focus group for practitioner (i.e., teachers, support assistants and school leaders) (online or in-person)
